We were only given a day to stuff all 30 containers, hence an extremely time-critical job. Our scope also included lashing, choking and transporting all the containers to Tanjung

Comessa cargoes - primarily machine parts of weight ranging from 400 kg to 21 tons in different shapes and sizes - were picked up from Seremban to Port Klang before being stuffed into two flat racks and four high cube containers at our warehouse.
