## Oil & Gas - Export of World's Largest Splitting Column



We recently transported two units of Splitting Column known to be the world's largest. Standing at 4.20 m height and over 30 meters long, we loaded them at client's fabrication yard to a private jetty for the RORO onto a barge to be exported.
