Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Malaysia is currently under the Movement Control Order (MCO). Multi-Trans is in compliance of the government's restrictions and the safety guidelines. Covering a distance of more than 70 kilometers, Megalift transported an oversized Pressure Vessel from Kemaman to Petronas's chemical plant in Gebeng. Due to the height of the cargo, they had to take a detour instead of a direct route to avoid several overhead bridges. The trailer typically moved along narrow passageways, trudged through villages and small towns before cruising along the coastal road to arrive at the chemical plant.
